What We're Learning Next

Reading: Our focus in reading will be looking at and comparing two texts on the same topic. We will examine things that are the same and different within the texts. We will also be discussing surface level and deep level comparisons.

AKS: compare and contrast the most important points presented by two texts on the same topic (CCGPS) (2LA.B.2012-18/ELACC2RI9)

Writing: In writing, students will write about and share their opinions. We will do many activities to encourage them to support their opinions with reasoning.

AKS: write opinion pieces in which they introduce the topic or book they are writing about, state an opinion, supply reasons that support the opinion, use linking words (e.g. because, and, also) to connect opinion and reasons, and provide a concluding statement or section (CCGPS) (2LA.D.2012-22/ELACC2W1)

Math: Our unit of study will focus on measurement. Our class will be analyzing what a ruler is and how to use a ruler for measurement, including standard and metric units of measurement.

AKS: measure length by determining, selecting and using an appropriate tool (rulers, yardsticks, meter sticks, measuring tapes) and unit (in., ft., yd., cm, m) (CCGPS) (2MA.G.2012-18/MCC2.MD.1)

Science- Williamson: We are excited to start exploring our universe! We will be learning all about the planets, stars, sun, and moon, including why the seasons change and how our shadows change during the day.

AKS: describe the universe as including the moon, sun, other stars, and planets (GPS) (2SC.B.2007-7); investigate the position of the sun and moon to show patterns throughout the year (GPS) (2SC.B.2007-8)

Social Studies- Lammey: We will be learning about the lives and accomplishments of Georgia heroes: Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Jackie Robinson, and Jimmy Carter.

AKS: read about and describe the lives of historical figures Martin Luther King Jr. and Jackie Robinson (GPS)(2SS.F.2008-28); read about and describe the life of Jimmy Carter (GPS) (2SS.O.2008-32)

Word Work: We will explore the -ore and -ue word patterns this week.

- ore more, shore, tore, store
