## What We're Learning Next



<u>Reading</u>: Our class will be studying character traits and how readers can describe a character's actions and personality using descriptive words. AKS: describe how characters in a story respond to major events and challenges (CCGPS) (2LA\_A2012-3/ELACC2RL3)

<u>Writing</u>: We will continue our unit on biographies. Our class will be finishing our interviews and creating a biography on one of our classmates. AKS: write informative/explanatory texts in which they introduce a topic, use facts and definitions to develop points, and provide a concluding statement or section (CCOPS) (2LA\_D2012-23)

<u>Math</u>: Last week we worked on adding 2-digit numbers with regrouping. This week, we will apply what we know about adding 2-digit numbers to problem solving. AKS: use addition and subtraction within 100 to solve one- and two-step word problems involving situations of adding to, taking from, putting together, taking apart, and comparing, with unknowns in all positions, e.g., by using drawings and equations with a symbol for the unknown number to represent the problem. (CCOPS) (MCC\_2\_OA\_1)
