What We're Learning Next

Reading: Students have been using context clues and their background knowledge to understand new vocabulary while reading. We will continue applying these skills as we work on making inferences (understanding details to figure out what the author is trying to tell the reader). AKS: determine the meanings of words and phrases in a text relevant to a grade 2 topic or subject area (CCOPS) (2LA_B2012-13/ELACC2RI4)

<u>Writing:</u> We will continue to explore how-to stories, using sequence words like first, next, and then. AKS: write informative/explanatory texts in which they introduce a topic, use facts and definitions to develop points, and provide a concluding statement or section (CCGPS) (2LA_D2012-23)

Math: Our class has been working on 2-digit subtraction using base 10 blocks to model our thinking. We will continue to build our understanding of subtraction with regrouping by applying this skill to problem solving. AKS: fluently add and subtract within 100 using strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction. (CCGPS) (MCC.2.NBT.S)

Science: Lammey: We will be finishing up our study of matter and physical and chemical changes. We will take our Matter test on Wednesday. A study guide came home and should be in your child's STAR. AKS: investigate the properties of matter and changes that occur in objects (GPS) (2SC_C2007-10)

Social Studies: Williamson; We have completed our unit on the life of Native Georgians, including the Creek and Cherokee Native Americans and Sequoyah, the creator of the Cherokee alphabet. We will be finishing up our study of matter and physical and chemical changes. We will take our Matter test on Wednesday. A study guide came home and should be in your child's STAR. AKS: describe the cultural and geographic systems associated with Sequoyah and Georgia's Creeks and Cherokees (GPS) (2SS_E2008-26)

Word Work: We will be reviewing the word patterns from the 2nd 9 weeks

Students have set and are working toward their AR goals for the nine weeks. Ask your student about their goal. You can access their AR account
