What We're Learning Next

Reading: Students will be applying and developing their understanding of how context clues and text features can be used as tools to help figure out the meaning of vocabulary words within a passage. AKS: determine the meanings of words and phrases in a text relevant to a grade 2 topic or subject area (CCGPS) (2LA_B2012-13/ELACC2RI4)

<u>Writing:</u> We will continue to explore how-to stories, using sequence words like first, next, and then. AKS: write informative/explanatory texts in which they introduce a topic, use facts and definitions to develop points, and provide a concluding statement or section (CCGPS) (2LA_D2012-23)

Math: Our class has been working on 2-digit subtraction using base 10 blocks to model our thinking. We will continue to build our understanding of subtraction with regrouping by applying this skill to problem solving. AKS: fluently add and subtract within 100 using strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction. (CCGPS) (MCC.2.NBT.S)

Science: Mrs. Lammey's class will continue our study of matter and physical and chemical changes. Our unit will include many hands on experiments as we learn the states of matter and its properties. The study guide for our assessment will go home this week

AKS: investigate the properties of matter and changes that occur in objects (OPS) (2SC C2007-10)

Social Studies: Mrs. Williamson's will learned many new things about the lives of the Creek Indians last week! We will continue our unit on the life of Native Georgians, including the Creek and Cherokee Native Americans and Sequoyah, the creator of the Cherokee alphabet. AKS: describe the cultural and geographic systems associated with Sequoyah and Georgia's Creeks and Cherokees (GPS) (2SS E2008-26)

Word Work: We will explore the —ie and —or vocabulary words using this week.

Students have set and are working toward their AR goals for this nine weeks.
