

What We're Learning Next



Writing: Next week we will begin to learn how to take all of the seed ideas we have been brainstorming and write a story from them. AKS: Write narratives in which they recount a well-elaborated event or short sequence of events, include details to describe actions, thoughts, and feelings, use temporal words to signal event order, and provide a sense of closure (CCOPS) (2LA D2012-24)

<u>Math:</u> We will begin our math unit on place value. We will begin by learning how to skip count by 5's, 10's, and 100's. AKS: Count within 1000; skip-count by Ss, 10s, and 100s (CCOPS) (2MA_B2012-10/MCC2.NBT.2)

<u>Science:</u> We will have our science test over Animal Life Cycles on Tuesday. Thank you for your flexibility in the date of the test being moved!

<u>Science:</u> Mrs. Lammey's class will begin their unit on animal lifecycles including; the frog, chicken, butterfly, and cat. AKS: Investigate the life cycles of different organisms to understand the diversity of life (GPS) ($2SC_D2007-13$)

Social Studies: Mrs. Williamson's class will begin their unit_on the S regions in Georgia. We will learn about what makes each part of Georgia unique while also practicing our map skills. Look for a study guide coming home next week. AKS: Locate major topographical features of Georgia on a map (GPS) C28S C2008-18)
