<u>**Reading:**</u> Next week we will be exploring the structure of a story by asking and answering questions. AKS: Describe the overall structure of a story, including describing how the beginning introduces the story and the ending concludes the action (CCOPS) (2LA_A2012-S/ELACC2RLS)

<u>Writing</u>: The rest of the nine weeks we will continue to work on personal narratives. AKS: Write narratives in which they recount a well-elaborated event or short sequence of events, include details to describe actions, thoughts, and feelings, use temporal words to signal event order, and provide a sense of closure (CCOPS) (2LA_D2012-24)

<u>Math</u>: We will wrap up our part 1 unit on base 10. AKS: Explain that the three digits of a three-digit number represent amounts of hundreds, tens, and ones (e.g., 706 equals 7 hundreds, 0 tens, and 6 ones) (CCGPS) (2MA_B2012-7)

<u>Science:</u> Mrs. Lammey's class will begin to learn about the life cycle of a plant. AKS: investigate the life cycles of different organisms to understand the diversity of life. (GPS) (2SC_D2007-13)

<u>Social Studies:</u> Mrs. Williamson's class will begin to explore the lives of James Oglethorpe, Mary Musgrave, and Tomochichi. AKS: Describe the cultural and geographic systems associated with James Oglethorpe, Tomochichi, and Mary Musgrove (OPS) (2SS_D2008-21)

Word Work: We will begin to explore the au and oi word patterns this week. -au haul, vault, fault

-oi boil, foil, spoil
